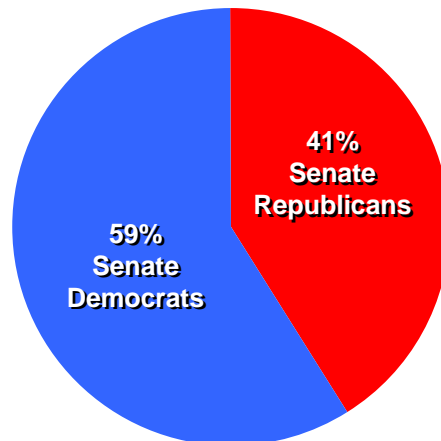

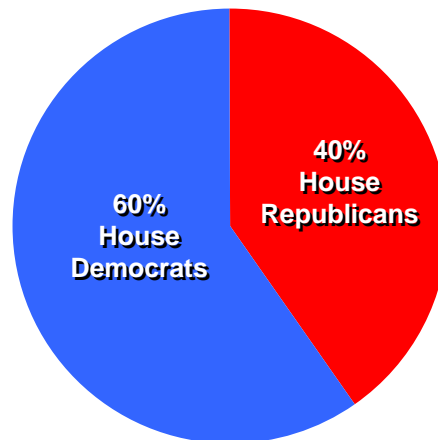

Non-Deductible Trade Association Dues

Upon the request of UnitedHealth Group, certain trade associations to which UnitedHealth Group has contributed more than \$50,000 in dues have reported that from January to December 2009, \$590,038.78 of the aggregate dues paid by UnitedHealth Group to those trade associations is used for contributions and expenditures that are not deductible under Section 162(e) of the Internal Revenue Code.
