Through our **2021 U.S. Political Contributions and Related Activity Report**, we seek to provide transparency into the Company's broad advocacy activities, including political contributions through UnitedHealth Group's bipartisan Political Action Committee – the UnitedHealth Group PAC – which is funded by voluntary employee contributions. Our PAC is managed by a long-established governance process that includes thorough review and approval of each contribution, public disclosure in compliance with applicable federal and state election laws, and the posting of semi-annual disclosure reports to UHG.com, in accordance with our [Political Contributions Policy](#).

Guided by our mission and values, we remain committed to good corporate governance and engaging in public policy and political activities focused on addressing the country's most pressing health care challenges and opportunities.

POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS AND RELATED ACTIVITY OVERVIEW

At UnitedHealth Group, our 340,000 colleagues are united in our mission to help people live healthier lives and help make the health system work better for everyone.

UnitedHealth Group is working to build a health system with improved access, affordability, outcomes and experiences – not only for the 146 million people who we serve today, but for all Americans.

To achieve our mission, we embrace our responsibility to engage in efforts to help shape and inform public policy decisions that have the potential to improve the quality and delivery of health care and that affect our employees, consumers, customers, and the people and communities we are privileged to serve. Our participation in the political process – including making bipartisan political contributions – is part of our efforts to advance solutions that focus on ensuring all people have access to affordable, high-quality health care.

ADVOCACY ACTIVITIES

POLICIES, PRACTICES, AND PRIORITIES

UnitedHealth Group participates in activities to advocate for our positions on public policy issues with elected officials and other stakeholders at the international, federal, state, and local levels – issues that affect our company, shareholders, team members, customers, and consumers. Our legislative and advocacy priorities are set forth in **The Path Forward**, our perspectives and solutions for how to create a modern, high-performing health system, and in our **Sustainability Report**, which highlights actions we're taking to build a health system that works better for everyone in the near and long term. Both thought leadership documents are available on UHG.com. UnitedHealth Group files federal lobbying disclosure reports quarterly with the U.S. Congress, which are available [here](#), and state lobbying disclosure reports with the appropriate state governing agencies and in compliance with applicable laws.

PROCEDURES AND BOARD AND MANAGEMENT OVERSIGHT

Political activities, including political contributions, lobbying, and advocacy efforts, are led by UHG External Affairs, with participation across our businesses, and are subject to oversight by UHG Executive leadership and the Governance Committee of the Company's Board of Directors (the "Committee"). In addition to overseeing political activities, the Committee assists the Board of Directors in fulfilling its responsibilities relating to our environmental, social and governance (ESG) activities and is responsible for overseeing the risks associated with these activities. The Committee receives regular reports from our leadership on these matters, oversees our policies, and reviews the purposes and benefits of these activities at each meeting. The Committee provides reports of its activities to our Board of Directors at each meeting. Our activities include educational outreach and promotion, campaign contributions, and, in certain instances, lobbying and other related activities. These activities are reviewed by legal counsel in addition to the Committee and are included in the total annual fiscal budget, which is subject to the approval and oversight of our Board of Directors. UnitedHealth Group made no independent expenditures in 2021. All UnitedHealth Group PAC and corporate political contributions are made in accordance with applicable election laws. The Company's Board of Directors adopted a Political Contributions Policy which is available on UHG.com. The Political Contributions Policy summarizes the policies and procedures followed with respect to political contributions.
