# Political Contributions and Related Activity Report

## OVERVIEW

**At UnitedHealth Group, our mission is to help people live healthier lives and help make the health system work better for everyone.**

In support of advancing our mission, we believe it is our responsibility – on behalf of the people and communities we serve, our employees, shareholders, and businesses – to engage in the public policy arena while navigating an evolving health care landscape. We remain focused on promoting solutions to help build a health system that is simpler, more connected, and delivers higher-quality outcomes at a lower cost. Our efforts include:

- Developing public policy solutions.
- Educational outreach.
- Participating in trade associations.
- Directly engaging policymakers.
- Making political contributions on a bipartisan basis – including through the Company’s political action committee, the UnitedHealth Group PAC.

In this Report, we provide further transparency into our participation in these activities through the disclosure of political contributions made between January 1 and December 31, 2025. UnitedHealth Group’s core public policy priorities – expanding access to care, improving health care affordability, and enhancing the health care experience – form the basis that guides and informs the Company’s decisions regarding political contributions and public policy engagement.

We also detail our governance practices, including board oversight and compliance. Our Board of Directors has enhanced corporate governance policies over time to align with best practices, drive sustained shareholder value, and respond to the interests of our stakeholders.

*Our political giving comes with the understanding that we may not agree with every position taken by each recipient of political contributions from the Company on the many issues considered by policymakers and candidates for public office. This Report provides retrospective information for the applicable period. Past support of a candidate or an organization cannot be assumed to mean that the Company and/or its PACs are providing similar support today. We regularly review recipients of political contributions.*

# Our Approach, Policies, and Procedures

## BOARD OVERSIGHT

The Governance Committee of the UHG Board of Directors has oversight of political contributions and related activity. The Governance Committee's responsibilities include:

- Overseeing the manner in which the Company conducts its public policy and government relations activities, including political contributions.
- Reviewing political contributions budgeting and spending.
- Reviewing quarterly reports of political contributions made by the Company and its political action committees and approving the public disclosure of such contributions semi-annually.
- Reviewing and recommending to the Board any changes to the Company's [Political Contributions Policy](#).
- Monitoring the Company's advocacy and lobbying processes and activities, including key trade association and coalition memberships.
- Approving and providing regular oversight of the Company's total annual fiscal budget, which includes advocacy activities.
- Overseeing the Company's external relations functions and activities.

The Governance Committee receives regular reports from Company leadership on these matters, oversees our policies, and reviews the purposes of these activities at each meeting. Our activities include developing public policy solutions, educational outreach, trade association memberships, lobbying, and making political contributions on a bipartisan basis.

## PUBLIC POLICY PRIORITIES

UnitedHealth Group's approach to political contributions and advocacy is grounded in our public policy priorities.

We are committed to a future where every person has access to high-quality, affordable health care and a modern, high-performing health system that reduces disparities, improves outcomes, and lessens the burden of disease. We publicly describe our core public policy priorities – **expanding access to care**, **improving health care affordability**, and **enhancing the health care experience** – and outline actionable and timely solutions to achieve these priorities in UnitedHealth Group's [A Path Forward](#). We also detail additional actions and commitments to help build a modern, high-performing health system and achieve our mission in our [Sustainability Report](#).

## FEDERAL AND STATE LOBBYING

Our lobbying activities are based on our public policy priorities. Examples of key policy issues on which we advocate include stability for Medicare Advantage beneficiaries, approaches to increasing access to affordable health care, and proposals related to making prescription drugs more affordable, simplifying the health care experience, accelerating value-based care, and a transition to paperless health care communications.

Lobbying activity is highly regulated. UnitedHealth Group maintains strict compliance with applicable federal and state laws, including the Lobbying Disclosure Act and Honest Leadership and Open Government Act. We file lobbying disclosure reports quarterly with the U.S. Congress, which are [available here](#), and state lobbying disclosure reports with the appropriate state governing agencies. The Governance Committee oversees the Company's lobbying processes and activities.

# Our Approach, Policies, and Procedures

## POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS

In support of advancing our mission, we engage in efforts to inform public policy decisions, including making political contributions on a bipartisan basis.

### *UnitedHealth Group PAC*

The Company's political action committee – the UnitedHealth Group PAC – is funded by voluntary, personal contributions from eligible employees and individuals. The PAC makes contributions to federal and state candidates and political committees on a bipartisan basis. All PAC contributions are disclosed regularly to the Federal Election Commission (FEC) and appropriate state agencies.

In addition to filing regular disclosure reports with the FEC and applicable state agencies, we disclose political contributions via semi-annual reports on our website, in accordance with our [Political Contributions Policy](#).

### *Corporate Political Contributions*

Federal election law prohibits using corporate treasury funds to contribute to federal candidates and political parties. We make corporate political contributions in some states, where permissible, and in accordance with state election laws.

In addition to filing disclosure reports with state agencies where applicable, we disclose political contributions via semi-annual reports on our website, in accordance with our [Political Contributions Policy](#).

UnitedHealth Group made no independent expenditures in 2025.

### *Governance*

Our [Political Contributions Policy](#), adopted by the UHG Board of Directors, summarizes the policies and procedures we follow with respect to political contributions.

We have a robust internal review process in place to evaluate every political contribution to ensure alignment with our public policy priorities and advocacy objectives, manage reputational risk for the Company, and comply with applicable laws and requirements. The review process for every political contribution includes:

- Evaluation by multiple leaders and staff members within UnitedHealth Group's Government Affairs organization during the development of political contribution budgets and when a contribution is made.
- Additional candidate contribution vetting by a third-party vendor.
- Approval by a designated Senior Vice President of Government Affairs.
- Compliance review by both a third-party vendor prior to processing a contribution and by our Corporate Legal Department.

As part of our review process, several factors are considered when making a contribution, including a candidate's role in advancing health care policy priorities that impact the Company and the people we serve. Our participation in the political process comes with the understanding we may not agree with recipients of political contributions on all issues.

# Our Approach, Policies, and Procedures

## TRADE ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIPS

We believe participating in industry and trade associations is important to advancing our mission and is in the best interest of the people and communities we serve, our employees, shareholders, and businesses. The majority of organizations in which we participate are national, state, and local business groups, provider groups, professional trade associations, or represent health plans.

We are committed to engaging our key trade association partners as we work to advance our public policy priorities. Our participation in these associations comes with the understanding that we might not always agree with all positions held by the organizations, and that we are committed to communicating and aligning, as appropriate, on our priority public policy positions, outlined in [A Path Forward](#). We routinely evaluate the effectiveness of our memberships in trade associations.

Trade associations may allocate a portion of dues received for certain non-deductible lobbying and political expenditures under Section 162(e)(1)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code. In this Report, we have listed trade associations that received dues from the Company totaling \$50,000 or more in a given year and the portion of dues attributed to non-deductible lobbying and political expenditures.

The Governance Committee oversees the Company's memberships in trade associations and coalitions.
