42% (378,853) of Medicare beneficiaries in Louisiana were enrolled in Medicare Advantage (MA) in 2020.


The average Medicare Advantage and Prescription Drug (MA-PD) plan beneficiary in Louisiana spends:



\$2,261 Less than a beneficiary in Louisiana who enrolls in traditional Medicare Fee-For-Service (FFS) and a prescription drug plan (PDP)

\$2,616 Less than a beneficiary in Louisiana who also purchases **Medigap Plan G as supplemental coverage for medical out-of-pocket costs**

In addition to the dental, vision, and hearing benefits typically offered, **the average MA-PD beneficiary in Louisiana receives \$164 in annual supplemental benefits**, such as care coordination, meals and non-emergency transportation, not offered by Medicare FFS.
