

Oregon Medicare Advantage Beneficiaries Receive Better Value and Spend 32% Less than Beneficiaries in Medicare FFS

47% (422,428) of Medicare beneficiaries in Oregon were enrolled in Medicare Advantage (MA) in 2020.

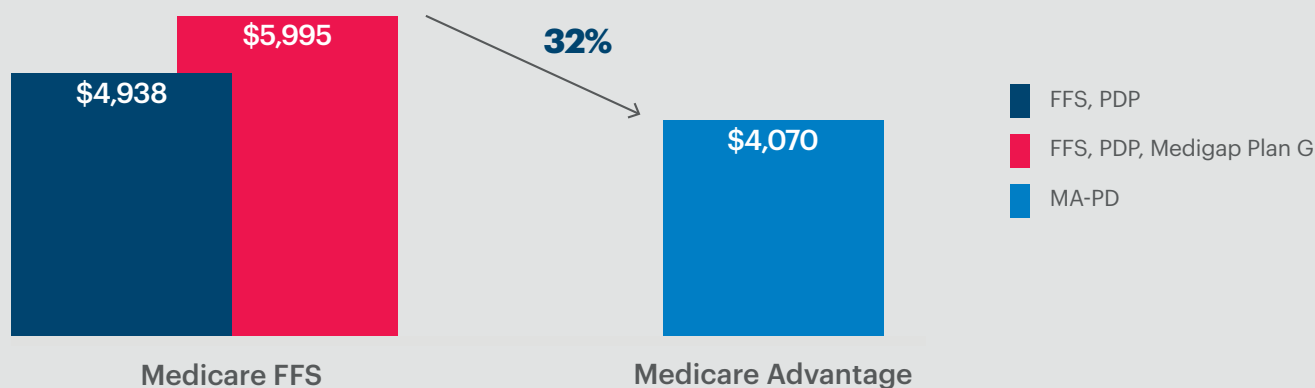
The average Medicare Advantage and Prescription Drug (MA-PD) plan beneficiary in Oregon spends:



\$869 Less than a beneficiary in Oregon who enrolls in traditional **Medicare Fee-For-Service (FFS) and a prescription drug plan (PDP)**

\$1,926 Less than a beneficiary in Oregon who also purchases **Medigap Plan G as supplemental coverage for medical out-of-pocket costs**

Within All Age Groups, Oregon's Beneficiaries in MA-PD Spend Less than those in Medicare FFS

\$682 to \$1,656 Less
than a **65-year old** FFS
beneficiary in average health



\$1,247 to \$2,524 Less
than an **85-year old** FFS
beneficiary in average health

In addition to the dental, vision, and hearing benefits typically offered, **the average MA-PD beneficiary in Oregon receives \$99 in annual supplemental benefits**, such as care coordination, meals and non-emergency transportation, not offered by Medicare FFS.
