### Site champion

Individual helps:

- Remove barriers from a leadership perspective
- Approves site events and communications
- Provides strategic support



#### Leader

Individuals help:

- Approve site events and communications
- Ensure alignment to ECC strategy and business objectives
- Is focused on building strong relationships



#### Chair

Individuals help:

- Most involved with annual planning
- Delegate volunteers for planned activities
- Complete post-event surveys
- Ensure alignment to ECC strategy
- Attend ECC leadership meetings as well as attend and facilitate monthly site meetings



#### **General members**

Individuals help:

- Assist with annual planning
- Lead 1–2 activities per year
- Join subcommittees and support volunteers joining planned events
